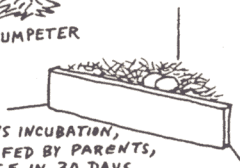

- pigeon farms supply gourmet restaurants with squabs - delicious dark meat.
- pigeon manure is nearly odor-free, rich fertilizer for gardens.
- pigeons and doves important in vitamin history, physiology, psychology, neurology and vision research.
- educational for biology classes, 4-H, fun-hobby projects.
- decorative, for example Fantails or Capuchins free-flying.
- very tolerant of heat and cold, can breed all year.
- care and feeding simple, small coops suitable.
- many thousands of fanciers world-wide, city and country, from all walks of life, all ages.
- enjoyable competition in flying performance, breeding for exhibition, buying and selling.
